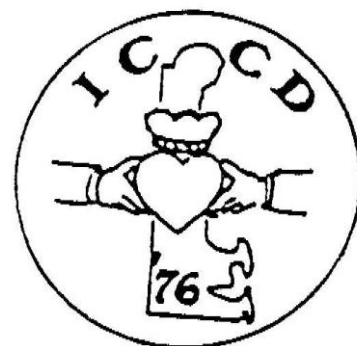

Beginner is a competitor who has not taken Irish dancing lessons from a registered teacher to September 1st of previous year. A Beginner must move into Advanced Beginner the following year. Videotaping allowed.

2 Steps, 2 Dancers at a time. Competitors in Beginner and Advanced Beginner must wear either a school costume or blouse & skirt. **NO SOLO COSTUMES.**
